#### "POVERTY FREE SOCIETY WITH JUSTICE AND EQUALITY"



<u>09.0 Prachestha 2023: (18 Aug 2023):</u> A literature cum cultural programme organized by students of IGIT Sarang Students with collaboration with IGIT High School Students. In this event IGIT High School students are participating in various activity like quiz, essay writing and cultural events and B.Tech students are coordinating them and conducting the activity. In this event a total of 106 students are coordinating the event.



<u>10.0 Plastic Free campaign 20 Nov 2023:</u> Many people in India aren't aware of how plastic waste harms the environment or the importance of disposing of it properly. This leads to littering and pollution. A survey found that only about 20% of Indians are aware of plastic waste recycling options. This programme is conducted by SSG in collaboration with IYDP (Govt of Odisha). Around 200 students participated in this event.





11. Road Safety Walk: (21 Nov 2023): Road safety is the prevention of road accidents by obeying the road safety rules and regulations. The most important factor of road safety is the need for skilful and cautious driving so that passengers, pedestrians and drivers stay safe. Developing better roads is also important to avoid road accidents. A rally is organized by the students of IGIT sarang to aware the public about the road safety in collaboration with IYDP. Around 200 students participate in this event.
