**INDIAN FOREST SERVICE EXAMINATION, 2023**

Based on the result of the written part of the Indian Forest Service Examination, 2023 held by the UNION PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION from 26<sup>th</sup> November to 03<sup>rd</sup> December, 2023, and the interviews for Personality Test held from 22<sup>nd</sup> April to 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2024, following is the list, in order of merit, of candidates who have been recommended for appointment to the posts in Indian Forest Service.

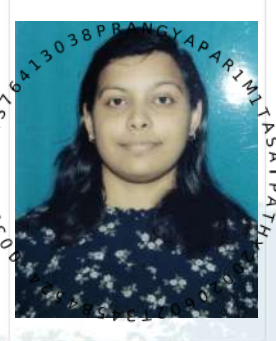
