

Minutes of meeting

Following are the minute of the meeting held at Damol village regarding Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA 2.0).

1. It was observed that due to the unevenness of the land (up and down) in the village, the supply of water to each house is not uniform.
2. It is found that people of the village are suffering from various diseases due to river pollution caused by the nearby industries, which also includes polluted drinking water. It is observed that the village water supply and environment is polluted due to the above stated reason. Again it is found that Health Center is far away from the village, the villagers are not getting adequate medical attention whenever it is required.
3. Due to lack of teaching staff in school (UP School) children of the village are facing lots of problems for the minimum education. They have to either travel a long distance to continue their education or stop schooling after 8th class.
4. Even though there is canal for the village for cultivation and other purpose, it does not have any water.
5. It is found that the village doesn't have sufficient number of toilets, which is affecting the village environment negatively.

6. Few person in the village have expertise hand in areas like plumbing, fittings, sewing etc. So if some provision or help can be extended to the villagers they can be self employed and thus lots of problems would have been minimized automatically.
7. The village is having very poor road connectivity to the surrounding villages/towns.
8. After getting the un-cleanliness of the village surroundings, it has been decided to provide dustbins to the village so as to maintain a clean atmosphere for daily living hood before Durga Puja.
