Applications are invited in the prescribed format for the post of Medical Officer for Indira Gandhi Institute of Technology, Sarang, Dhenkanal. The detailed advertisement containing Pay Scale, Eligibility Criteria & General Information and the prescribed application form can be downloaded from the institute website www.igitsarang.ac.in. The candidate should enclose a Demand Draft of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) [Rs.200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) for SC/ST] drawn in favor of "Principal Indira Gandhi Institute of Technology, Sarang" payable at State Bank of India, IGIT Sarang (Code: 10246) along with the application form. The Applicants in employment at present should apply through proper channel. The last date of receipt of complete Application Form is **20th April 2022** during office hours by Speed Post only. The Institute will not be responsible for any postal delay. The qualifications, eligibility criteria etc. as on the last date of receipt of Application only will be considered. The Institute reserves the right to fill-up or not to fill-up the post advertised or to cancel the entire selection process without assigning any reason thereof.

Name of the Post: - Medical Officer

Category: - Unreserved

Number of Vacancy: - 01 (One)

Pay Scale: Level-12, Cell-1 of Rs. 56,100/- of ORSP Rules, 2017,

(with usual Dearness and other Allowances as may be sanctioned by the Government of Odisha from time to time.)

Eligibility Criteria: In order to be eligible for recruitment to the post of Medical Officer, a candidate shall have to satisfy the following conditions, namely:-

- Nationality- She /He must be a citizen of India;
- Age limit- She /He must have attained the age of 21 years and must not be above the age of 38 years as on 31st March 2022.
Date of birth entered in the High School Certificate or equivalent certificate issued by the concerned Board/Council will only be accepted by the Institute.
- Knowledge in Odia- The candidate must
 - be able to read, write and speak Odia,
 - have passed Middle School Examination with Odia as language subject; or
 - have passed matriculation or equivalent examination with Odia as medium of examination in non-language subject;

or

- have passed in Odia as language subject in the final examination of class-VII from a school or educational Institution recognized by the Government of Odisha or the Central Government;

or

- have passed a test in Odia in Middle English School standard conducted by the School and Mass Education Department.
- If a candidate has not passed Middle School Examination with Odia as a Language Subject, he shall be allowed to pass the examination conducted by Board of Secondary Education, Odisha within two years of joining the service failing which no further increment shall be sanctioned.
- Marital status- If married, the candidate must not have more than one spouse living; provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such candidate or there are other specific grounds for doing so, exempt any candidate from the operation of this rule.
- Minimum Educational Qualification- The educational qualification of the candidate for the post of Medical Officer shall be as follows:
A candidate:
 - must have possessed M.B.B.S. Degree from a Medical College or Medical Institution recognised by the Medical Council of India,

- (ii) Must have a valid registration certificate under the Odisha Medical "Registration Rules 1965"; and
- (iii) Must have possessed required conversion certificates recognised by Medical Council of India (MCI) in case of candidate having Degrees from Universities of Foreign Countries.
- g) Physical Fitness- The candidate must be of good mental and physical health and free from any physical defects likely to make him incapable of discharging her/his normal duties in the Service.
- h) A candidate who after such medical examination as the Government may prescribe is not found to satisfy these requirements as specified in clause (g) shall not be appointed to the Service.

General Information:

1. The Institute reserves the right to fill-up or not to fill-up the post advertised or even to cancel the entire selection process without assigning any reason thereof.
4. No correspondence whatsoever will be entertained from the candidates regarding postal delays, conduct and result of selection and reasons for not being selected. The decision of the Institute in all matters is final.
5. Persons employed in Government, Semi-Government, Private or Autonomous organizations must apply through proper channel or they shall be required to submit the No Objection Certificate from the Employer during the time of interview.
6. The envelope containing the duly filled-in application form should be superscribed "Application for the post of Medical Officer".
7. **The application shall be accepted by Speed Post only in the address "Registrar, Indira Gandhi Institute Technology, Sarang, Dhenkanal, PIN: 759146, Odisha". No hand or courier delivery is acceptable.**
8. Each page of the application and all annexure(s) (certificates, mark sheets, experience certificates etc.) must bear the full signature of the candidate at the bottom of the page and is mandatory. Two recent passport size color photographs are required to be attached with the application form one of which should be affixed on the application form.
9. The short listed candidates are required to attend the selection process at their own expenses. No TA / DA are admissible. The candidates are required to produce their original certificates, testimonials & other relevant documents for verification.
10. Application(s) received after the last date shall not be entertained and Institute will not be responsible for any postal delay.
11. Incomplete applications and/or applications not in proper format (as provided at Institute website) and/or without full signature of the candidate will be summarily rejected.
12. Any dispute with regard to the selection / recruitment process will be subject to Hon'ble Court having jurisdiction over Kamakhyanagar, Dhenkanal / Hon'ble High Court of Odisha.
